

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in February 2023 was 201,000 persons, an increase of 5,300 employed persons, or 2.7% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, February 2023

- The unemployment rate in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in February 2023 was 3.0 per cent, a decrease of 0.3 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the eighth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in February 2023 was 79.3 per cent, an increase of 0.8 percentage point over the year (Table 1).
