


Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Brisbane - North SA4





Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, March 2023

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Brisbane North SA4 in March 2023 was 129,500 persons, a decrease of 3,600 employed persons, or 2.7% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Brisbane North SA4 in March 2023 was 2.4 per cent, a decrease of 1.3 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the fourth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Brisbane North SA4 in March 2023 was 69.9 per cent, a decrease of 4.2 percentage points over the year (Table 1).
