

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Cairns SA4 in March 2023 was 140,800 persons, an increase of 5,200 employed persons, or 3.8% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, March 2023

- The unemployment rate in Cairns SA4 in March 2023 was 4.2 per cent, a decrease of 0.2 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the seventhhighest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Cairns SA4 in March 2023 was 68.9 per cent, an increase of 1.1 percentage points over the year (Table 1).



Totals may differ due to rounding. Figures are rounded to nearest 100 persons. Calculations are based on pre-rounded figures.
