




#### Employment growth, annual

### **Main findings**

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Mackay Isaac -Whitsunday SA4 in March 2023 was 107,300 persons, an increase of 3,500 employed persons, or 3.4% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Mackay Isaac Whitsunday SA4 in March 2023 was 2.5 per cent, an increase of 0.2 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the fifth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Mackay Isaac Whitsunday SA4 in March 2023 was 72.2 per cent, an increase of 0.4 percentage point over the year (Table 1).
