




#### Employment growth, annual

### Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Moreton Bay South SA4 in March 2023 was 126,400 persons, an increase of 11,000 employed persons, or 9.5% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Moreton Bay South SA4 in March 2023 was 2.8 per cent, a decrease of 2.0 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the seventh-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Moreton Bay South SA4 in March 2023 was 73.4 per cent, an increase of 3.0 percentage points over the year (Table 1).
