



Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Toowoomba SA4 in March 2023 was 77,700 persons, an increase of 4,800 employed persons, or 6.6% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, March 2023

- The unemployment rate in Toowoomba SA4 in March 2023 was 4.8 per cent, a decrease of 0.5 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the sixthhighest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Toowoomba SA4 in March 2023 was 60.5 per cent, an increase of 2.0 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Toowoomba SA4
