


Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Townsville SA4





Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, March 2023

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Townsville SA4 in March 2023 was 131,300 persons, an increase of 9,700 employed persons, or 8.0% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Townsville SA4 in March 2023 was 2.2 per cent, a decrease of 1.3 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the second-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Townsville SA4 in March 2023 was 70.2 per cent, an increase of 3.0 percentage points over the year (Table 1).
