



## **Main findings**

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Wide Bay SA4 in March 2023 was 128,600 persons, an increase of 9,400 employed persons, or 7.9% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, March 2023

- The unemployment rate in Wide Bay SA4 in March 2023 was 5.8 per cent, a decrease of 1.0 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the fourth-highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Wide Bay SA4 in March 2023 was 50.5 per cent, an increase of 1.8 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Wide Bay SA4
