


Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Cairns SA4





Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, April 2023

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Cairns SA4 in April 2023 was 140,800 persons, an increase of 4,300 employed persons, or 3.2% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Cairns SA4 in April 2023 was 3.8 per cent, a decrease of 0.8 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the seventh-highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Cairns SA4 in April 2023 was 68.5 per cent, an increase of 0.2 percentage point over the year (Table 1).
