



Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Mackay Isaac -Whitsunday SA4 in April 2023 was 107,300 persons, an increase of 3,600 employed persons, or 3.4% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, April 2023

- The unemployment rate in Mackay Isaac Whitsunday SA4 in April 2023 was 2.4 per cent, unchanged over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the thirdlowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Mackay Isaac Whitsunday SA4 in April 2023 was 71.8 per cent, an increase of 0.2 percentage point over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Mackay - Isaac - Whitsunday SA4
