



Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Wide Bay SA4 in April 2023 was 130,100 persons, an increase of 10,600 employed persons, or 8.9% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, April 2023

- The unemployment rate in Wide Bay SA4 in April 2023 was 5.6 per cent, a decrease of 1.0 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the fourthhighest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Wide Bay SA4 in April 2023 was 50.9 per cent, an increase of 2.2 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Wide Bay SA4
