

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Central Queensland SA4 in May 2023 was 129,500 persons, an increase of 12,200 employed persons, or 10.4% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, May 2023

- The unemployment rate in Central Queensland SA4 in May 2023 was 3.7 per cent, a decrease of 1.5 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the seventh-highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Central Queensland SA4 in May 2023 was 71.3 per cent, an increase of 4.0 percentage points over the year (Table 1).
