Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Ipswich SA4 in May 2023 was 190,000 persons, an increase of 6,100 employed persons, or 3.3% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, May 2023

- The unemployment rate in Ipswich SA4 in May 2023 was 6.0 per cent, a decrease of 0.5 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the third-highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Ipswich SA4 in May 2023 was 66.8 per cent, a decrease of 0.6 percentage point over the year (Table 1).
