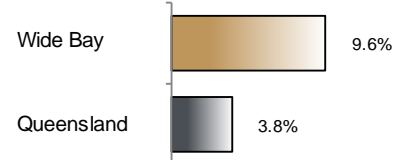

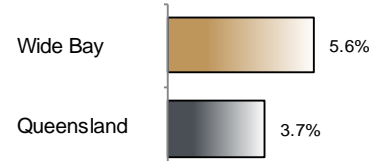

## Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Wide Bay SA4 in May 2023 was 131,500 persons, an increase of 11,500 employed persons, or 9.6% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Wide Bay SA4 in May 2023 was 5.6 per cent, a decrease of 1.1 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the fourth-highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Wide Bay SA4 in May 2023 was 51.1 per cent, an increase of 2.3 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

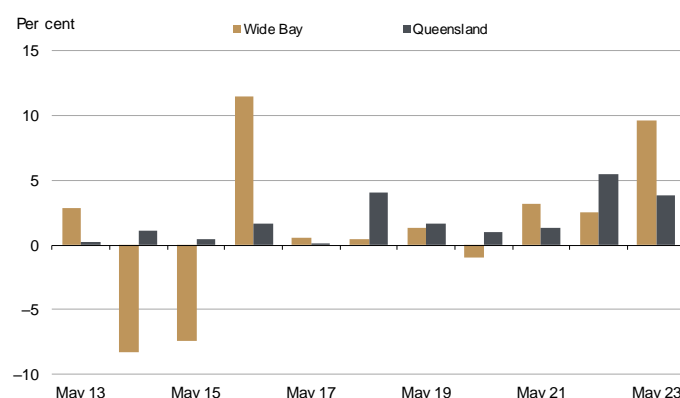
