





Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Brisbane South SA4 in June 2023 was 212,900 persons, an increase of 6,600 employed persons, or 3.2% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, June 2023

- The unemployment rate in Brisbane South SA4 in June 2023 was 3.0 per cent, a decrease of 1.6 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the eighth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Brisbane South SA4 in June 2023 was 69.9 per cent, a decrease of 0.1 percentage point over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Brisbane - South SA4
