



Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Queensland Outback SA4 in June 2023 was 36,500 persons, a decrease of 500 employed persons, or 1.4% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, June 2023

- The unemployment rate in Queensland Outback SA4 in June 2023 was 9.1 per cent, a decrease of 1.9 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Queensland Outback SA4 in June 2023 was 61.9 per cent, a decrease of 3.5 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Queensland - Outback SA4
