


Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Wide Bay SA4





Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, June 2023

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Wide Bay SA4 in June 2023 was 132,700 persons, an increase of 12,400 employed persons, or 10.3% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Wide Bay SA4 in June 2023 was 5.7 per cent, a decrease of 0.9 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the fourthhighest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Wide Bay SA4 in June 2023 was 51.5 per cent, an increase of 2.7 percentage points over the year (Table 1).
