


#### Employment growth, annual

## Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Darling Downs -Maranoa SA4 in July 2023 was 66,200 persons, a decrease of 900 employed persons, or 1.3% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Darling Downs Maranoa SA4 in July 2023 was 3.0 per cent, a decrease of 3.0 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the sixth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Darling Downs Maranoa SA4 in July 2023 was 63.4 per cent, a decrease of 4.4 percentage points over the year (Table 1).
