



## **Main findings**

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Ipswich SA4 in July 2023 was 192,400 persons, an increase of 8,000 employed persons, or 4.3% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Ipswich SA4 in July 2023 was 5.5 per cent, a decrease of 1.0 percentage point over the year.




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, July 2023

  The unemployment rate for this area was the fourth-highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Ipswich SA4 in July 2023 was 66.8 per cent, a decrease of 0.4 percentage point over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Ipswich SA4
