



Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Sunshine Coast SA4 in July 2023 was 213,500 persons, an increase of 17,800 employed persons, or 9.1% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, July 2023

- The unemployment rate in Sunshine Coast SA4 in July 2023 was 2.9 per cent, a decrease of 0.3 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the fourth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Sunshine Coast SA4 in July 2023 was 62.0 per cent, an increase of 2.8 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Sunshine Coast SA4
