

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in August 2023 was 198,100 persons, unchanged over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, August 2023

- The unemployment rate in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in August 2023 was 3.2 per cent, an increase of 0.7 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the eighth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in August 2023 was 77.4 per cent, a decrease of 0.9 percentage point over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Brisbane Inner City SA4
