


Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Sunshine Coast SA4





Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, August 2023

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Sunshine Coast SA4 in August 2023 was 216,000 persons, an increase of 18,800 employed persons, or 9.5% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Sunshine Coast SA4 in August 2023 was 3.0 per cent, an increase of 0.1 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the third-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Sunshine Coast SA4 in August 2023 was 62.6 per cent, an increase of 3.2 percentage points over the year (Table 1).
