



## **Main findings**

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Ipswich SA4 in September 2023 was 195,200 persons, an increase of 10,100 employed persons, or 5.5% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, September 2023

- The unemployment rate in Ipswich SA4 in September 2023 was 4.8 per cent, a decrease of 1.7 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the fifthhighest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Ipswich SA4 in September 2023 was 66.8 per cent, a decrease of 0.3 percentage point over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Ipswich SA4
