





## **Main findings**

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Queensland Outback SA4 in September 2023 was 36,900 persons, an increase of 300 employed persons, or 0.8% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Queensland Outback SA4 in September 2023 was 9.2 per cent, a decrease of 2.0 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Queensland Outback SA4 in September 2023 was 62.2 per cent, a decrease of 2.2 percentage points over the year (Table 1).
