





Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Queensland Outback SA4 in November 2023 was 36,800 persons, an increase of 1,200 employed persons, or 3.3% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, November 2023

- The unemployment rate in Queensland Outback SA4 in November 2023 was 8.7 per cent, a decrease of 2.3 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Queensland Outback SA4 in November 2023 was 62.9 per cent, a decrease of 0.2 percentage point over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Queensland - Outback SA4
