

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Brisbane West SA4 in December 2023 was 105,300 persons, unchanged over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, December 2023

- The unemployment rate in Brisbane West SA4 in December 2023 was 2.7 per cent, a decrease of 1.0 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the second-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Brisbane West SA4 in December 2023 was 68.2 per cent, a decrease of 2.1 percentage points over the year (Table 1).
