





### Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Brisbane North SA4 in January 2024 was 126,500 persons, a decrease of 5,000 employed persons, or 3.8% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Brisbane North SA4 in January 2024 was 3.6 per cent, an increase of 1.1 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the eighth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Brisbane North SA4 in January 2024 was 67.8 per cent, a decrease of 3.6 percentage points over the year (Table 1).
