



Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Brisbane South SA4 in January 2024 was 216,500 persons, an increase of 5,300 employed persons, or 2.5% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, January 2024

- The unemployment rate in Brisbane South SA4 in January 2024 was 3.7 per cent, an increase of 0.5 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the ninth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Brisbane South SA4 in January 2024 was 69.9 per cent, an increase of 0.3 percentage point over the year (Table 1).



Totals may differ due to rounding. Figures are rounded to nearest 100 persons. Calculations are based on pre-rounded figures.
