






### Employment growth, annual

## **Main findings**

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Brisbane West SA4 in January 2024 was 104,600 persons, a decrease of 1,800 employed persons, or 1.6% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Brisbane West SA4 in January 2024 was 2.6 per cent, a decrease of 1.0 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the second-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Brisbane West SA4 in January 2024 was 67.6 per cent, a decrease of 3.3 percentage points over the year (Table 1).
