### **Main findings**

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Cairns SA4 in January 2024 was 140,300 persons, a decrease of 2,100 employed persons, or 1.5% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, January 2024

- The unemployment rate in Cairns SA4 in January 2024 was 3.4 per cent, a decrease of 0.7 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the fourthlowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Cairns SA4 in January 2024 was 66.6 per cent, a decrease of 3.3 percentage points over the year (Table 1).


