



## Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Gold Coast SA4 in January 2024 was 361,300 persons, a decrease of 4,800 employed persons, or 1.3% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Gold Coast SA4 in January 2024 was 3.4 per cent, an increase of 0.7 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the fifth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Gold Coast SA4 in January 2024 was 66.0 per cent, a decrease of 2.6 percentage points over the year (Table 1).
