



Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Ipswich SA4 in January 2024 was 201,500 persons, an increase of 13,900 employed persons, or 7.4% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, January 2024

- The unemployment rate in Ipswich SA4 in January 2024 was 4.3 per cent, a decrease of 2.3 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the seventh-highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2)
- The participation rate in Ipswich SA4 in January 2024 was 67.7 per cent, an increase of 0.4 percentage point over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Ipswich SA4
