

# Regional labour force - Mackay - Isaac - Whitsunday SA4, Jan 24





## **Main findings**

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Mackay Isaac -Whitsunday SA4 in January 2024 was 104,500 persons, a decrease of 2,500 employed persons, or 2.3% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, January 2024

- The unemployment rate in Mackay Isaac Whitsunday SA4 in January 2024 was 4.0 per cent, an increase of 1.8 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the eighth-highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Mackay Isaac Whitsunday SA4 in January 2024 was 70.6 per cent, a decrease of 2.3 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Mackay - Isaac - Whitsunday SA4
