



Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Brisbane East SA4 in February 2024 was 137,400 persons, an increase of 4,600 employed persons, or 3.5% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, February 2024

- The unemployment rate in Brisbane East SA4 in February 2024 was 3.5 per cent, an increase of 1.6 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the sixth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Brisbane East SA4 in February 2024 was 69.4 per cent, an increase of 2.1 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Brisbane - East
