


Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Toowoomba SA4





Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, February 2024

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Toowoomba SA4 in February 2024 was 77,800 persons, an increase of 2,200 employed persons, or 2.9% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Toowoomba SA4 in February 2024 was 4.7 per cent, a decrease of 0.4 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the fourth-highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Toowoomba SA4 in February 2024 was 58.9 per cent, a decrease of 0.4 percentage point over the year (Table 1).
