

# Retail trade, April 2023

### **Key data**

## **Main findings**

Note: Commentary on monthly figures is based on nominal values throughout and, as such, movements are affected by price and quantity changes.

Due to the impacts of COVID-19 the ABS has suspended the trend series from February 2020. All results are therefore presented in seasonally adjusted terms.

- The seasonally adjusted estimate of Queensland's retail turnover increased 0.1% in April 2023.
  Australia's seasonally adjusted retail turnover decreased by less than 0.1% in April 2023.
- The seasonally adjusted value of Queensland's nominal retail turnover increased from \$7,195.1 million in March 2023 to \$7,204.8 million in April 2023.




Figure 2 Annual change in retail turnover, April 2023

- The seasonally adjusted value of Queensland's retail turnover increased by 1.5% over the previous 12 months, from \$7,099.2 million in April 2022 (Figure 2).
- South Australia recorded the highest annual growth in retail trade of all states and territories (7.6%).

Figure 1 Monthly change in retail turnover
