Main findings

Note: Commentary on monthly figures is based on nominal values throughout and, as such, movements are affected by price and quantity changes.

Due to the impacts of COVID-19 the ABS has suspended the trend series from March 2020 to June 2022 (inclusive). At present, all results in this brief are presented in seasonally adjusted terms.

- The seasonally adjusted estimate of Queensland's retail turnover increased 2.2% in November 2023. Australia's seasonally adjusted retail turnover increased 2.0% in November 2023.
- The seasonally adjusted value of Queensland's nominal retail turnover increased from \$7,331.6 million in October 2023 to \$7,495.8 million in November 2023.




Figure 2 Annual change in retail turnover, November 2023

- The seasonally adjusted value of Queensland's retail turnover increased by 1.7% over the previous 12 months, from \$7,370.2 million in November 2022 (Figure 2).
- Australian Capital Territory recorded the highest annual growth in retail trade of all states and territories (5.3%).

Figure 1 Monthly change in retail turnover
