

Main findings

Note: Commentary on monthly figures is based on nominal values throughout and, as such, movements are affected by price and quantity changes.

Due to the impacts of COVID-19 the ABS has suspended the trend series from March 2020 to June 2022 (inclusive). At present, all results in this brief are presented in seasonally adjusted terms.

- The seasonally adjusted estimate of Queensland's retail turnover decreased 0.5% in February 2024. Australia's seasonally adjusted retail turnover increased 0.3% in February 2024.
- The seasonally adjusted value of Queensland's nominal retail turnover decreased from \$7,368.6 million in January 2024 to \$7,329.5 million in February 2024.




Figure 2 Annual change in retail turnover, February 2024

- The seasonally adjusted value of Queensland's retail turnover increased by 2.5% over the previous 12 months, from \$7,150.6 million in February 2023 (Figure 2).
- Queensland recorded the second-highest annual growth in retail turnover of all states and territories (2.5%). Northern Territory recorded the highest increase (3.6%).
