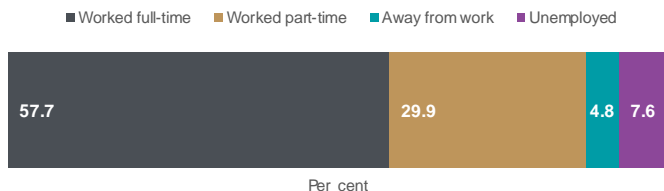


Queensland and Australia

People working **full-time**

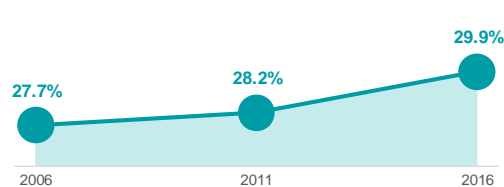
57.7% in both **Queensland** and **Australia**

1 in every **10** employed Queenslanders worked **1–15 hours** per week

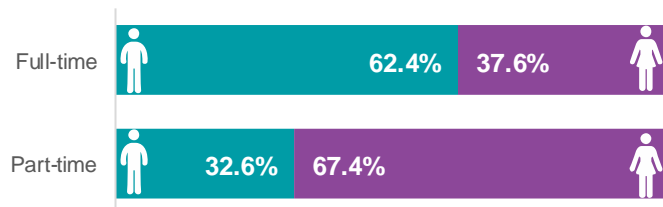
Median age of employed persons was **similar**

39 years part-time **40 years**

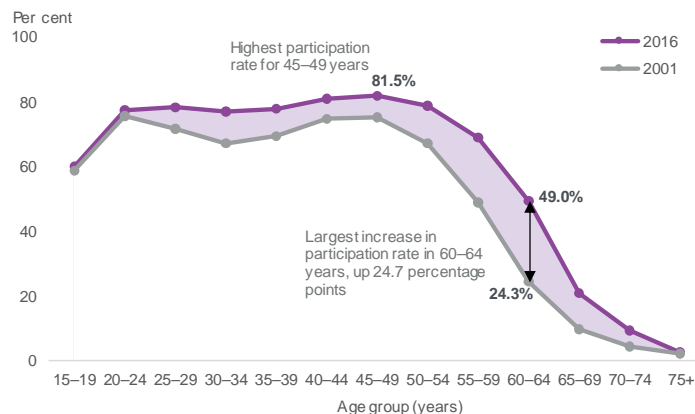
Full-time workers in **Queensland** more likely to be **men**

Female participation in the **Queensland** labour force **increased** over time



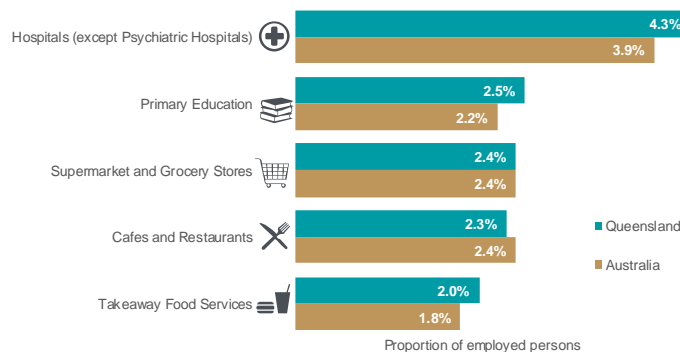
Occupation

1 in every **5** employed Queenslanders worked as **Professionals**

Community and Personal Service Workers occupation group increased the most since 2011

Clerical and Administrative Workers occupation group decreased by **2.7%**, the most since 2011
