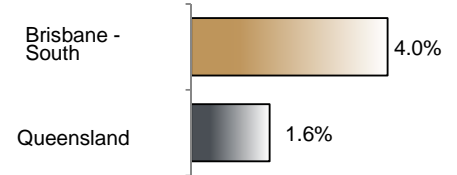

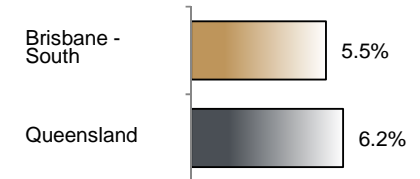

Main findings

Note: All data in this report are based on a 12-month moving average.

- The number of employed persons in Brisbane - South SA4 in June 2016 was 197,600 persons, an increase of 7,600 employed persons, or 4.0% over the year (Figure 1).

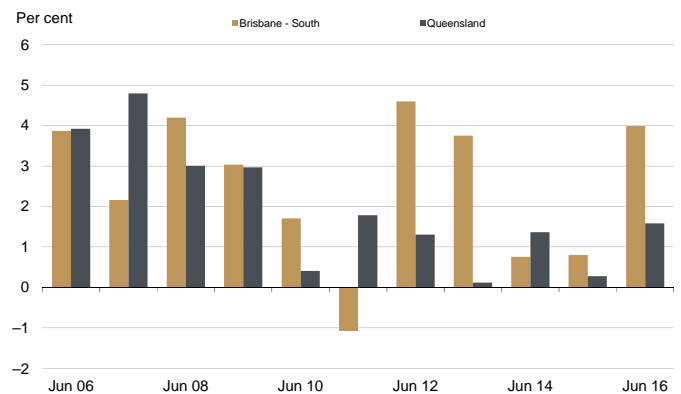


Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, June 2016

- The unemployment rate in Brisbane - South SA4 in June 2016 was 5.5 per cent, a decrease of 0.2 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the tenth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Brisbane - South SA4 in June 2016 was 72.0 per cent, an increase of 1.7 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Brisbane - South SA4
