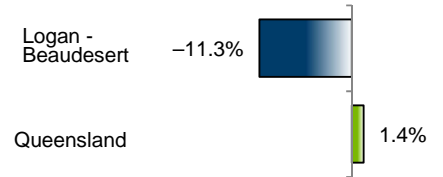

Unemployment rate

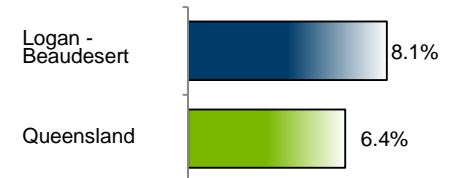


Figure 1: Annual change in employment, Logan - Beaudesert SA4

Main findings

Note: All data in this report are based on a 12-month moving average.

- The number of employed persons in Logan - Beaudesert SA4 in December 2014 was 126,000 persons, a decrease of 16,000 employed persons, or 11.3% over the year (Figure 1).

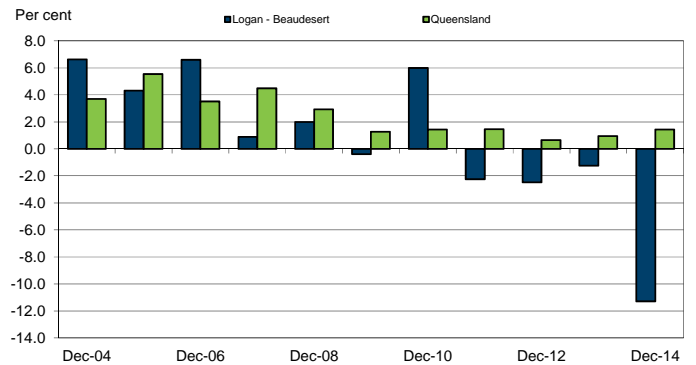
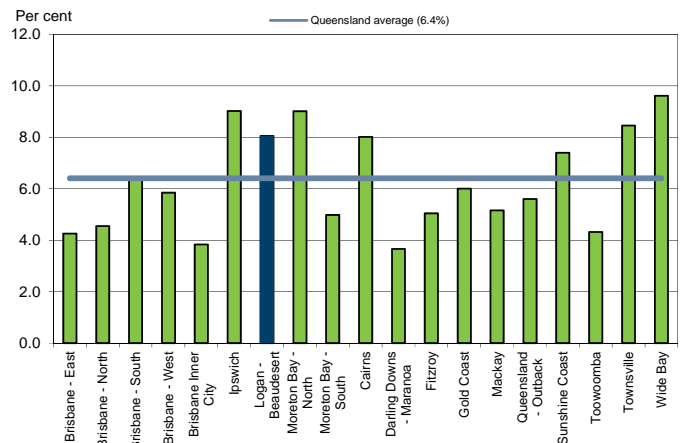


Figure 2: Unemployment rate by SA4, December 2014

- The unemployment rate in Logan - Beaudesert SA4 in December 2014 was 8.1 per cent, an increase of 1.6 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the fifth-highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Logan - Beaudesert SA4 in December 2014 was 55.6 per cent, a decrease of 7.0 percentage points over the year (Table 1).
