Main findings

Note: All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages. This approach is supported by ABS advice on analysis of regional labour force estimates (see Table 16(b) of *Labour Force, Australia, Detailed* (cat. no. 6291.0.55.001)).

- Mackay SA4 had the lowest youth unemployment rate of all 19 SA4s during October 2018 with an unemployment rate of 6.6 per cent (Figure 1).
- Queensland - Outback SA4 had the highest youth unemployment rate of all 19 SA4s during October 2018 with an unemployment rate of 33.1 per cent (Figure 1).

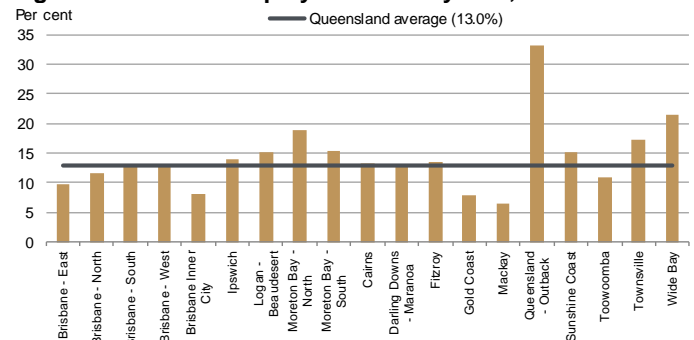
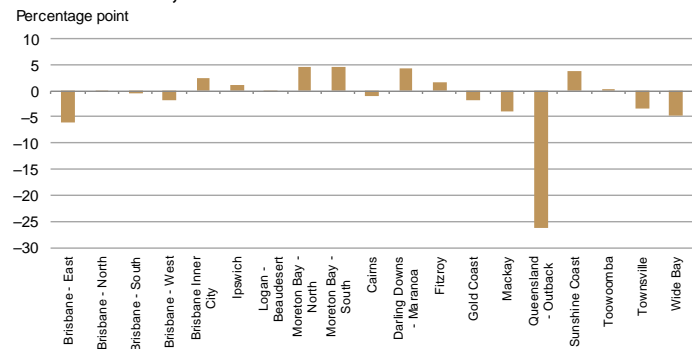


Figure 2 Annual change in youth unemployment rate by SA4, October 2018

- Queensland - Outback SA4 had the largest percentage point decrease in the youth unemployment rate of all 19 SA4s over the year to October 2018 with an unemployment rate decrease of 26.3 percentage points (Figure 2).
- Moreton Bay - North SA4 had the largest percentage point increase in the youth unemployment rate of all 19 SA4s over the year to October 2018 with an unemployment rate increase of 4.7 percentage points (Figure 2).

Figure 1 Youth unemployment rate by SA4, October 2018
