1 in 5 Australians live in Queensland 5,156,138


Queensland has a higher proportion of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples

4.6% vs 3.2%

Queensland has a smaller proportion of people born overseas

24.1% vs 29.3%

Queenslanders are the same age on average (median age) 38 years vs 38 years

Queensland has fewer lone person households

24.7% vs **25.6%**

Queensland has larger proportion of people with a long term health condition
