

Queensland compared with Australia, 2021

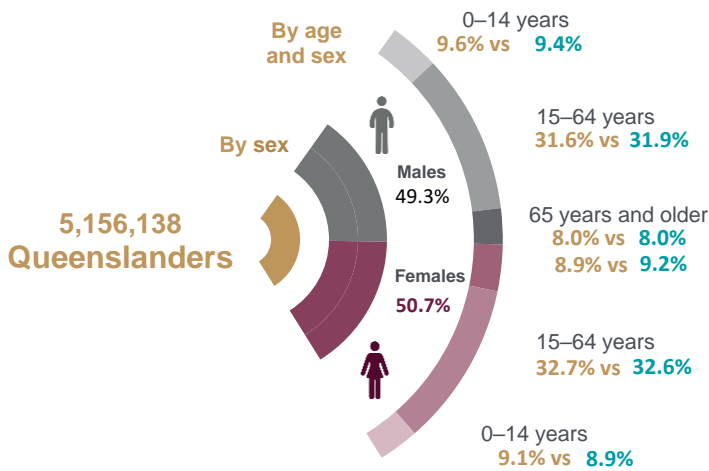
1 in 5 Australians live in **Queensland**

Queensland has a **higher proportion** of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples
4.6% vs **3.2%**

Queensland has a **smaller proportion** of people born overseas
24.1% vs **29.3%**

Queenslanders are **the same age** on average (median age)
