

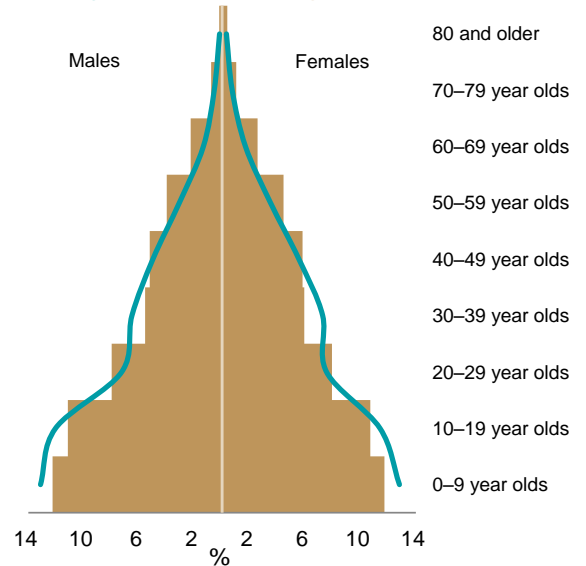
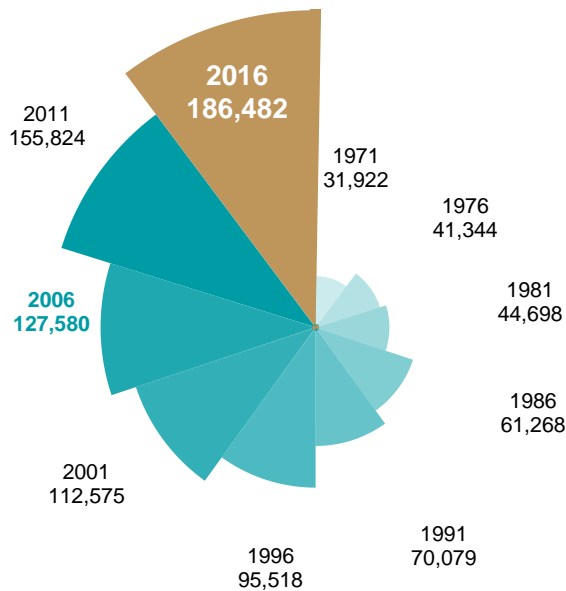
Queensland's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples

186,482 people in **2016**

Compared with **2006**, median age has **increased**

4.0% of all Queenslanders in **2016** compared with **3.3%** in **2006**

20 years to **22 years**



The population is still very young.....in every **100** people in **2016**, there were **46** aged 0-19 years

Housing and income



More dwellings are mortgaged

22.2% to **23.6%**

More dwellings are owned outright

9.8% to **10.3%**

Median monthly mortgage payments are **up** by **45.4%**

Fewer dwellings are rented

63.1% to **61.8%**



Median weekly rental payments are **up** by **80.0%**
