


Queenslanders working in the **Mining** industry had:

- the highest median full-time income \$113,876
- over 85% employed full-time
- over 8 in 10 employees were male




Queenslanders working in the **Accommodation and Food Services** industry had:

or were away from work during the reference week.


- the lowest median full-time income \$46,487

- over half of employees were female







Females In 2016 more females were employed as Professionals than Clerical and Administrative Workers for the first time...




Males while similar proportions of males worked in each occupation group between 2006 and 2016




More than 1 in 5 Sales Workers were studying, with 85.1% of those studying full-time
