## Main findings

Population statistics are impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic and the resulting Australian Government closure of the international border from March 2020.

The ABS is assessing the impact of changed traveller behaviour on overseas migration estimates, which is likely to result in more frequent revisions to preliminary overseas migration estimates to reflect the most timely data . available.

- Queensland's preliminary ERP at 30 September 2023 was 5,495,524 persons (20.5% of the Australian population). This reflects an increase of 143,589 persons over the 12 months, and 35,104 persons since 30 June 2023 (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Population growth rate, Australia and states and territories, year ending 30 September 2023

- Queensland recorded a population growth rate of 2.7% in the 12 months to 30 September 2023, above the national average (2.5%) and below Western Australia (3.3%) and Victoria (2.9%) (Figure 2).
- Net overseas migration made the largest contribution to population growth in Queensland in the 12 months to 30 September 2023 (61.3%) followed by net interstate migration (22.7%) and natural increase (16.0%) (Table 1).
- In the 12 months to 30 September 2023, natural increase (births minus deaths) was 23,010 persons, an increase from the 22,222 persons recorded during the 12 months to 30 June 2023.
- Net overseas migration for September quarter 2023 contributed 21,946 persons to Queensland's population, compared with a contribution of 18,994 persons in September quarter 2022.
- Net interstate migration contributed 32,625 persons to population change in Queensland over the 12 months to 30 September 2023, an increase from the 32,255 persons recorded during the 12 months to 30 June 2023.

Annual population increase by components of population change, Queensland




Figure 3 Annual population growth rate, Queensland and Australia
