

Main findings (trend)

Employment in Queensland rose by 4,400 persons (0.2%) in October 2023 to be 64,300 persons (2.3%) higher over the year and 286,900 persons (11.1%) above the pre-COVID level in March 2020. The rise in October was driven by an increase in part-time employment (up 6,200 persons) which more than offset a fall in full-time employment (down 1,900). In more volatile seasonally adjusted terms, Queensland's employment rose by 10,600 persons (0.4%) in October.

The employment-to-population ratio was 63.6% in October 2023, down from 63.7% in September but above its pre-COVID ratio of 62.0%. Hours worked rose 0.3% in October and was 12.5% above its level in March 2020 (**Chart 1**).


Chart 1: Employment and hours worked, Queensland



The unemployment rate was 4.2% in October, unchanged from an upwardly revised September 2023 and still well below the pre-COVID rate of 5.7% in March 2020 (**Chart 2**).

Queensland's participation rate was 66.4% in October 2023 unchanged from an upwardly revised September 2023, and well above its pre-COVID rate of 65.7%.

Nationally, employment rose by 28,300 persons in October (0.2%, **Table 1**) to be 2.8% higher over the year and 9.0% above the pre-COVID level of March 2020. In seasonally adjusted terms, national employment grew by 55,000 persons which greatly exceeded market expectations of 20,000 persons.

The national unemployment rate was unchanged at 3.7% in October (**Table 2**). Hours worked fell by 0.1% in the month but were up 2.6% over the year and 9.8% above the pre-COVID level.

The ABS noted, 'the recent slowdown in the growth of hours worked may suggest that the labour market is starting to slow, following a particularly strong period of growth.'
