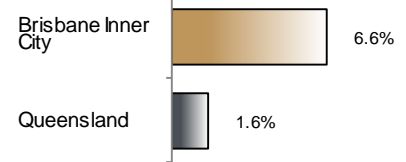

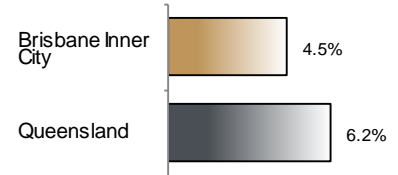

Main findings

Note: All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages. This approach is supported by ABS advice on analysis of regional labour force estimates (see Table 16(b) of *Labour Force, Australia, Detailed* (cat. no. 6291.0.55.001)).

- The number of employed persons in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in September 2019 was 178,500 persons, an increase of 11,100 employed persons, or 6.6% over the year (Figure 1).

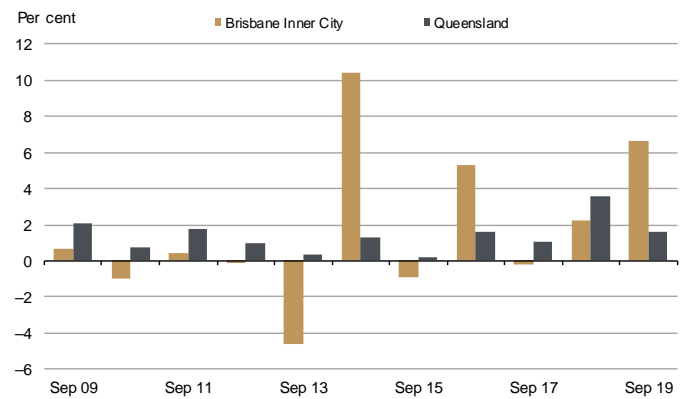


Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, September 2019

- The unemployment rate in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in September 2019 was 4.5 per cent, an increase of 0.3 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the second-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in September 2019 was 75.2 per cent, an increase of 2.5 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Brisbane Inner City SA4
