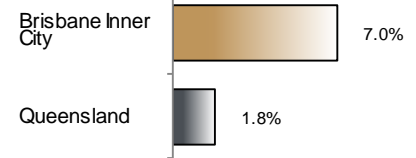

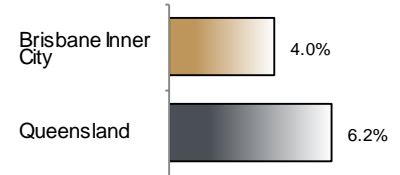

Main findings

Note: All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages. This approach is supported by ABS advice on analysis of regional labour force estimates (see Table 16(b) of *Labour Force, Australia, Detailed* (cat. no. 6291.0.55.001)).

- The number of employed persons in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in November 2019 was 180,900 persons, an increase of 11,800 employed persons, or 7.0% over the year (Figure 1).

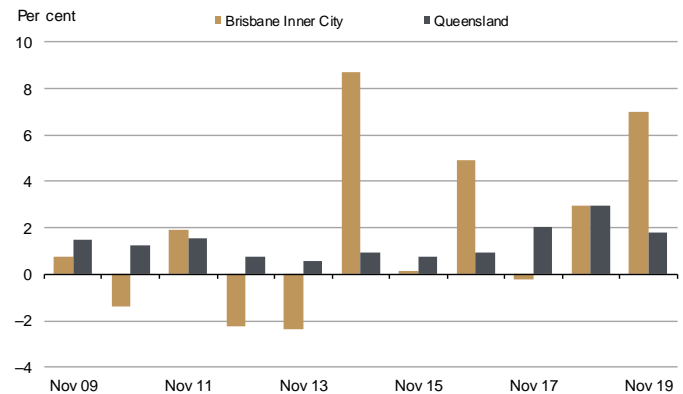


Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, November 2019

- The unemployment rate in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in November 2019 was 4.0 per cent, a decrease of 0.6 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the second-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in November 2019 was 75.4 per cent, an increase of 2.0 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Brisbane Inner City SA4
